Focus and content of course	<p>Senior Executive course participants will gain an overview of international best practices on road safety management issues and the key elements that need to be put in place for effective safety management. They will learn about management and coordination structures that have been successful, alternative funding mechanisms that have been adopted in different countries and about the safety legislation needed for effective work. They will learn about importance of crash data systems to develop performance indicators and how to institutionalize road safety activity by encouraging teaching and research on road safety issues</p> <p>During this course site visits will be made to key national and municipal organizations responsible for road safety to see how road safety issues are managed and progress monitored. Discussions with local experts will be organized to discuss such issues and problems that have to be overcome</p>
